Heavy Smoke Exposure

Animals should not be enclosed in a room with a stagnating cloud. Always provide access to fresh air or the outdoors.

Cannabis Edibles

Consumption of cannabis edibles may pose an additional risk as they often contain other toxic substances including **chocolate, raisins, or xylitol** (sugar-free sweetener).

IF YOUR PET HAS INGESTED ANY AMOUNT OF THC OR OTHER TOXINS:

- **Bring your pet to an animal emergency room immediately.**
 - Waiting will give the THC and other toxins time to digest, which will cause more harm to your animal.
- **Bring the packaging and a list of ingredients of what your pet ingested.**
 - This will make sure only necessary treatments are provided and prevent unnecessary costs.
- **Animals normally do well with supportive care, however large ingestions of marijuana can be dangerous.**
