



SEEK IMMEDIATE VETERINARY HELP: With fast and appropriate action, your dog has a good chance of recovery.

Symptoms:

- Sudden weakness and possible collapse
- Swollen area
- Puncture wounds
- Bleeding or bruising
- Trembling, twitching, and shaking
- Dilated pupils
- Diarrhea
- Vomiting
- Bloody urine
- Paralysis

Take action:

- 1. Stay calm
- 2. Try to identify if it's a venomous or nonvenomous snake bite.
 - If your pet has been bitten by a venomous snake there will be significant swelling in the bite area.
- 3. Keep the wound below the heart



Can a dog survive a snake bite?

About **80% of dogs can survive a snake bite if it's treated right away.** If left untreated, dogs are less likely to recover.



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
